### **HARMONY WEEK 2024**

Harmony Week is the celebration that recognises our diversity and brings together Australians from different backgrounds. Harmony Week will take place from 18-24 March 2024 with Thursday, 21 March 2024 being Harmony Day. The theme this year is "*Everyone Belongs*".

Cloverdale Primary School is made up of students and families from many different countries, nationalities and cultures which enhances our unique multi-cultural community.

On Friday, 22 March 2024, Cloverdale Primary School and the Cloverdale Education Support Centre will celebrate Harmony Week at a special assembly in the Undercover Area at 9:00am. Students may choose to wear something ORANGE (the official colour of Harmony Day) or traditional dress/colours to represent their country of origin.



#### Naplan - National Assessment Program

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual assessment for students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9.

It is a nationwide measure through which parents/carers, teachers, schools, education authorities, governments and the broader community can determine whether or not young Australians are developing the literacy and numeracy skills that provide the critical foundation for other learning and for their productive and rewarding participation in the community.

NAPLAN results allow parents/carers and educators to see how students are progressing in literacy and numeracy over time – individually, as part of their school community, and against national standards.

This week our Year 3 and Year 5 students have been sitting the NAPLAN tests of Writing, Reading, Conventions and Language (spelling, grammar, and punctuation) and Numeracy. Students who have missed the tests this week, will be given an opportunity to catch up the following week.

Week 2 and 3 - RESPECT & RESPONSIBILITY - Whole body listening.

Week 4 and 5 – ACHIEVEMENT - Listen to and follow instructions.

Week 6 and 7 - SAFETY - Maintain personal space.

Week 8 and 9 - ORGANISATION - Be on time.



Please talk with your child about the school expectations around the topics. Certificates are presented at our PBS assemblies on the Monday assembly.

Our whole school reward day is **Thursday**, **28 March 2024**. The students who have followed our expectations for the term will be rewarded with a water play session. Students can wear free dress (for messy mud play) on the day. Each class will go with their buddy class to the designated area for their time.


