## Sick Children

Please do not send your child to school if he/she is unwell. While regular attendance is very important, your child should be at home when they are sick. Today we had 63 children away...about 20% of the students who should have been here. We also had 6 members of staff away due to being sick. Unwell children will be sent home, so please make sure that your details and the details of your emergency pick-up person are up to date.

## Reporting to Parents - Information

- If you have not already done so, you need to book a 10-minute interview with your child's teacher for tomorrow.
- Information about how to book interview times has been provided through Audiri (Skoolbag).
- Face-to-face reporting is to go over the reports, address any issues the actual reports bring up and say nice things about the children. Parents who want a longer time to discuss their child will need to arrange that for another time.
- Interviews of 10-minute duration will start at noon, with the last time slot being at 5.50 pm. Please don't book back to back interviews for your children. Leave a 10-minute space so that interviews can run smoothly.

- OSHC will be running from 11.30 am for students who would normally attend OSHC, as well as students in the ESC. If you wish to use OSHC on the day, you will need to make a booking with Camp Australia who are our OSHC providers.

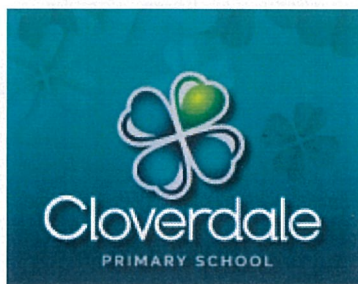
