Entering and Leaving School Grounds

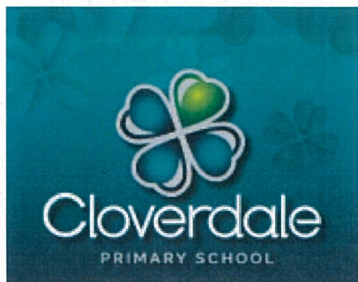
