Approximately 5000 students representing 101 public schools are involved over the nine nights. Each concert consists of a different massed choir of approximately 500 students as well as guest choirs each night. Concerts feature vocal soloists and student comperes from schools involved on the night. This has become an invaluable part of our concert series, providing variety and a fantastic opportunity for these students as performing to an audience of over 1000 members is a truly unique experience. A massive thank you to Mrs Bellenger for the time and effort that she has put into preparing the Choir for this event, and also to the Choir for giving up their time to rehearse. I am looking forward to hearing them perform on the night.
