## Students Arriving at School Early

We have children in our school who do not have permission to be filmed or photographed for personal and safety reasons. At the end of an assembly, the performing class will do their main performance again with any children not able to be photographed removed, and it is only then that you may film or take photos of the performance. If your child is getting a certificate, we ask you to pull them aside after assembly to take a picture of them individually, without their student peers present in the background. We thank all members of our community for their understanding and support in this matter.

## Massed Choir Festival

Cloverdale Primary School Choir will be performing as part of the WA Massed Choir Festival on Wednesday, September 13 at the Perth Concert Hall. One of our students, Paige in Year 6, has been selected as a soloist on the night, which is an outstanding achievement. Approximately 5,000 students representing 101 public schools are involved over the nine nights. Each concert consists of a different massed choir of approximately 500 students as well as guest choirs each night. Concerts feature vocal soloists and student compères from

schools involved on the night. This has become an invaluable part of our concert series, providing variety and a fantastic opportunity for these students as performing to an audience of over 1000 members is a truly unique experience. A massive thank you to Mrs. Bellenger for the time and effort that she has put into preparing the Choir for this event, and also to the Choir for giving up their time to rehearse. I am looking forward to hearing them perform on the night.
