Dear Families,

Welcome to Term 4! This term always seems to be the term with the most activity as classes prepare for the end of the school year and staff prepare for the start of the next school year. There are a number of ways that you can help us:

1. If your child will not be attending this school in 2022, please let either the class teacher know or call in to the Front Office and tell them.
2. If you know of any families that have a child who will be able to start school next year, but do not already have students attending school that they are able to enroll their child in Kindy for 2022. This applies to children who were born between July 2017 and June 2018.



PUBLIC SCHOOL REVIEW

The Public School Review (PSR) is a process whereby schools are required to provide information about the performance of the school, to ensure that as a school we are meeting the needs of our students and the community we serve. As part of this process members of the school community may be invited to comment on the performance of the school. This will be done in conjunction with the School Board and P&C, as well as individually. By completing the National School Opinion Survey (see next item) you will be assisting the school and providing valuable information for us.

NATIONAL SCHOOL OPINION SURVEY

All parents and carers will be receiving the National School Opinion Survey (NSOS) in the next two weeks. This survey is completed by staff, parents/carers, and students in Year 5 and Year 6. The purpose of the survey is to find out from all families their opinion of the school and their feelings, good or bad, about what happens here. The survey can be completed on line and a link will be sent out to all families and staff members. Students can either complete an on-line version or a paper-based form. Paper copies can also be made available in languages other than English.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT (PBS) AT CLOVERDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Cloverdale Primary School has been working in the last 18 months to build a school environment that promotes positive behaviours. This does not mean that prior to that we were promoting negative behaviours! What we are aiming to do is recognize and support positive behaviours that nearly all children have, or are aware of, teach those behaviours necessary to success, and to identify students requiring support to use more positive and successful behaviors. PBS is about recognizing the many students who do the right thing most of the time, and supporting those students needing help to behave well.



For Weeks 1 and 2 we are working on Organisation, which is part of our SOAR expectations, and specifically Being On Time. Our Classrooms open at 8:30am, to enable students to get ready to start learning at 8:45am.

HEALTHY EATING

At Cloverdale Primary School we promote healthy eating at all times. This means that we do not encourage foods that have a high sugar or fat component to be part of a child's diet at school. This also includes birthday cakes and goodie bags. Please support us by limiting the number of high sugar, high fat food items that your child is bringing to school. Similarly, birthday cakes. It is lovely to include your child's classmates in celebrating their birthday but we would ask that if you are going to provide a cake that it be on the small size or individual cakes such as cupcakes or mini muffins.



ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance ensures that children do not miss important parts of classroom teaching and learning. Of course, should your child be unwell please keep them at home as this is the best place for them. An important part of attendance is arriving at school on time, before 8.45 am. Children arriving after 8.45 am need to go to the Front Office to let us know that they are here before going to their class. Being late also places children in the position of missing out on instruction. Lateness is recorded by the school along with attendance and forms part of the data we collect as a school to report on our effectiveness.
